Bill was signed by Governor; effective August 28, 2008.</p>
<p><b>3. Compliance -- Government-Owned USTs</b> -- Onetime report from states is required</p>	Aug-07	EPA's final grant guidelines issued 4/24/07	<p>DNR sent report on compliance status of government-owned tanks to EPA on August 8, 2007; <a href="#">attached here</a>. <p><b>4. Public Record</b> -- States must make info available on number, sources &amp; causes of leaks; UST compliance; and number of equip failures</p>	First report due Sept 2008	EPA's final grant guidelines issued 1/23/07	<p>DNR filed its <a href="#">initial report</a> in December 2008.</p>
<p><b>5. Operator Training</b> -- EPA must issue guidelines that "specify training requirements" for 3 classes of employees</p>	<p>EPA guidelines due August 2007; states must begin implementation by August 2009</p>	EPA's final grant guidelines issued 8/8/07	<p>DNR is reviewing guidelines and will hold meetings with interested parties.</p>
