Well Data Now Available On Line!

Great news! DNR's Division of Geology and Land Survey has recently posted its "Well Information System" on the web, making it *much easier* for consultants to find well records near tank sites!

The data can be accessed at <http://dnr.mo.gov/mowells/>.

No longer will you have to contact the Wellhead Protection Section, or use out-of-date information from MEGA. You now have direct access to information on all recorded wells in Missouri.

Evaluating the "Domestic Use Pathway"

When groundwater has been or is likely to be impacted by a petroleum release, you must assess the current and future risk of people using the water. Remember:

- You must first decide how many "groundwater zones" exist, then assess each zone.
- Your conclusions affect site characterization requirements, so include this in your initial site conceptual model.
- This evaluation is required *regardless of* whether land use is residential or non-residential.
