Speaking of Wells . . . Eliminate Extra Paperwork!

The DNR Tanks Section has announced it does *not* need to receive "work plans" for plugging monitoring wells or well plugging reports.

After the Tanks Section issues a "No Further Action Letter," ***you need not send any more correspondence to DNR's Tanks Section.*** The PSTIF will continue to pre-approve costs for plugging the wells, and a permitted driller must submit well plugging forms and fees to DNR's Wellhead Protection Section, which can be done ***online.*** Only one signature (either driller or primary contractor) is required on the forms.

RBCA Training . . .

. . . Is being offered by a private vendor on May 13-14 in Overland Park, KS. It will cover regulators' requirements in Missouri, Kansas, and Illinois, including Missouri DNR's October 2013 Tanks RBCA Guidance and rules.
