Introduction to Horizontal Remediation Wells

Directional drilling was invented in the 1920s for the oil field industry to increase oil production and later adapted for utility installations in the 1990s for installing pipelines and conduits. This technology is now used to install horizontal remediation wells for the environmental industry to cost effectively remediate large subsurface areas, even within active and complex industrial sites, which is difficult or impossible with traditional vertical wells or other in situ approaches.
