Clarification - Construction Worker Exposures

DNR has issued a memo clarifying that you need not be concerned about construction worker exposures from COCs in an active tank pit. Reason: such workers are required to comply with industry standards that address human safety and exposures.

Free Money for Plugging Wells!

Money is available to plug old wells that may serve as a conduit to contaminate drinking water sources.
Applications for this year's funds are due by December 31, 2013.
